

Promax Nutrition Corp Announces a Voluntary Withdrawal on Selected Lots of Promax Chocolate Chip Cookie Dough Bars and Promax70 cal Double Fudge Bars.

Dear Valued Customer :

As you are most likely aware by now, Peanut Corp. of America has been involved in a salmonella outbreak and manufacturers are voluntarily withdrawing product from the marketplace that could be tainted with the bacteria.

Promax Nutrition Corp. is announcing that it is exercising extreme caution and enacting a voluntarily withdrawal of 2 lots of Promax Chocolate Chip Cookie Dough and 1 lot of Double Fudge Brownie 70calorie bars -- which contain peanut paste from Peanut Corp. of America.

While Promax uses outside independent labs to test all of its products, and has found no salmonella contamination, they are exercising an abundance of caution in withdrawing these bars -- which have tested negative for salmonella. To date, Promax has received no consumer complaints of any symptoms of salmonella from consuming their bars.

No other Promax products or flavors are included in this voluntary withdrawal .

5. Please destroy any remaining product.
